Instructions:

- 1. Kindly note that the Members can opt any one mode for voting i.e. either by physical ballot or e-voting. If you are opting for e-voting, then do not vote by physical ballot and vice versa. However, in case Member(s) cast their vote both via physical ballot and e-voting, then e-voting shall prevail and voting done by physical means shall be treated as invalid. A member desiring to exercise vote by physical postal ballot may complete this Postal Ballot Form and send it to the Scrutinizer in the attached self-addressed envelope. Postage will be borne and paid by the Corporation. However, envelopes containing postal ballots, if deposited in person or sent by Courier/Registered Post at the expenses of the Registered Shareholder will also be accepted.
- 2. This Form should be completed and signed by the member. Unsigned postal ballot form will be rejected. In case of joint holding, this Form should be completed and signed (as per specimen signature registered with the Corporation) by the first named member and in his absence, by the next named member.
- 3. In case shares are held by companies, trusts, societies etc., the duly completed Postal Ballot Form should be accompanied by a certified true copy of Board Resolution/Authority giving requisite authority to the person voting on the postal ballot form.
- 4. The self-addressed envelope bears the address of the Scrutinizer appointed by the Board of Directors of the Corporation.
- 5. Duly completed Postal Ballot Form should reach the Scrutinizer not later than the close of working hours i.e. 5:00 pm on 30th January, 2017. All Postal Ballot Forms received after this date will be strictly treated as if the reply from such member has not been received.
- 6. Postal Ballot Form received by fax will be rejected as if reply from member is not received unless the original Postal Ballot Form is received within the prescribed period.
